1959, nearly 559,000 mentally ill patients were housed in state mental hospitals (Lamb, 1998).

A shift to "deinstitutionalize" mentally ill persons had, by the late 1990s, dropped the number of persons housed in public psychiatric hospitals to approximately 70,000 (CorrectCare, 1999).
