Taking up where the author's book *Of Modern Dragons* (2007) left off, these essays continue Lennard's investigation of the praxis of serial reading and the best genre fiction of recent decades, including work by Bill James, Walter Mosley, Lois Mcmstraj Bujold, and Ursula K.
